There is a specific method that is explained by the refreshingly friendly staff. Showings are announced and viewers seated 30 minutes prior to the start of the movie with the intent of getting all the orders placed and delivered before the

actual feature begins. Menus are provided and guests are asked to pick out their entire meal from starters to desserts, all of which are delivered in slightly delayed intervals. Once the movie begins, the servers retreat so the guests can enjoy the feature presentation uninterrupted. However, if they do have a craving mid-movie, guests can order anything off the menu from the bar at any point. "If the guests order something that is going to take a little time, we give them a pager. They can go back and watch the movie while they are waiting," Sandra noted.

One of the most exciting services CineBistro offers is the ability to host a wide range of events. Whether it is a corporate meeting, a fundraiser or even a private cocktail party, they will gladly accommodate to the coordinator's needs. "We will provide our guests with an unforgettable experience," Sandra said.

This includes a reservation of an entire theatre, a showing of a movie as well as catering and more. CineBistro could very well be the most optimum location for any event.

CineBistro also hosts its own unique events. Last year they played the last five Monday Night Football games leading up to and including the Superbowl. This year they are considering a Sex and the City themed release party or even a Lost season finale showing for die-hard fans.
